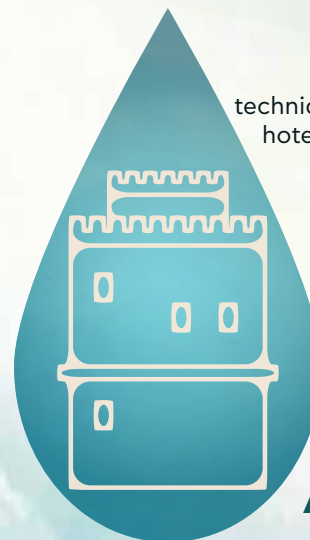
Registration fees for **sponsors** include one person registration for the conference and the sponsor's logo at the conference proceedings and program.
